- Batteries—Sainsburys, Redhill (bottom of the escalators by the noticeboard)
- Textiles—H & M—a carrier bag of textiles can earn you a £5 voucher to use when spending £25 or more
- Recycle at Boots—scan empty beauty, health, wellness & dental products from any brand, that can't be recycled at home. When you drop off 5 approved products & £10 spend then receive 500
